<u>Erratum 1:</u> Page 84, Sub-programme 5.7: Green Economy, Table 9.6.3 Sub-programme 5.7: Output indicators: Annual and quarterly targets

Ouput indicator 5.7 "Number of municipalities assisted with resource resilience improvements", should be verbatim as reflected in table 9.6.2, namely: "Number of municipalities assisted with resource (energy & water) resilience improvement".

Erratum 2: Page 129, Programme 2.2: Regional and Local Economic Development
