- The building is a series of 3 co-joined structures, two with a grading of IIIB and one graded IIIC.
- The City of Cape Town supports the proposal.

- The City Bowl Ratepayers and Residents Association (CIBRA) supports.
- The Cape Institute for Architecture (CIFA) supports the proposal with the following comments:
 - The existing signage carved into stone must remain visible as it speaks to the past life of the building.
 - The new signage is to be designed and mounted as a floating element in front of the circular window recess to circumvent the obscuring of existing details.
 - There should be consideration of a replacement entrance canopy structure which should be well designed and detailed as a lightweight element which could enhance both the building and the public domain. This would require heritage indicators to inform a suitable design.

FURTHER REQUIREMENTS:

The HOMS Committee generally supports the proposal; however, it requires

the submission of

- 1. A built fabric analysis
- 2. A methodology statement which must include further detailed information in respect of construction methods and specifications appropriate to the specific historic fabric.

This report must be compiled by a suitably qualified heritage practitioner with the relevant architectural experience.
