Safety Tips at Bank ATM's . Choose well-lit & well situated Bank ATMs . Do not accept help from any strangers, rather walk away immediately . Be on the lookout for "shoulder suffering"...people standing too close • Stand close to the ATM & shield the keypad while entering your Pin





Parking in Knysna is FREE...

if you wish to tip... please tip a Red Bib Parking Attendant

Beware of Remote Car Jamming! Always make sure your vehicle is locked before walking away... Don't leave anything in your parked car

in town or at your accommodation

· Store your valuables securely, ideally in a safe at your accommodation. . Never leave valuables near an open window. Don't walk alone at night. It is always better to explore in groups and to stick to well-lit, busy streets. . Rather use recommended TAXI services. . Ask your hosts, restaurant manager or shop owner for numbers and advice on where to go.
