
Approved Minutes of the Meeting of Heritage Western Cape Built Environment and Landscape Permit Committee (BELCom)

FURTHER REQUIREMENTS:

HWC cannot condone unauthorised work. It can only approve work that has yet to commence.

The Committee notes that the applicant intends to undertake the remedial work including replacements on a like for like basis where such replacements are necessary. Given the significance of the building, it is particularly important that the proposed work is of a nature that heritage significance will in fact not be negatively impacted. Consequently, the Committee requires that the work be monitored by an appropriately qualified and experienced heritage architect to the approval of HWC. The heritage architect will be required to do the following amongst others:

- 1. Prepare an accurate record of the structure in its current state identifying elements to be retained, elements to be removed and reinstated, and elements to be replaced.
- 2. Ensure that all elements to be retained are properly protected and that elements to be replaced are accurate reflections of what previously existed.

The work in no.1 above to be submitted to HWC with a method statement for the work yet to be completed; all for HWC's approval before proceeding further. The heritage architect will be required to submit a closeout report to HWC within 30 days of practical completion.
