




Figure 1. Longkloof Studios

Reason for Site Inspection:

Heritage Western Cape (HWC) Heritage Officer Committee meeting held on 6 September 2021; the committee resolved to undertake a site inspection on the respective matter as it is graded a IIIA. It is noted that work has begun hence the decision to take on the inspection in order to find out whether any heritage significance has been affected or impacted on.

Findings and Discussion:

With reference to the figure above, the site is located within a Heritage Protected Overlay Zone (HPOZ) and immediately exudes sufficient IIIA significance upon arrival. This HPO status as well as grading has contributed to the protection and preservation of the context of the area in order to warrant any alteration both internally and externally.

The minor works proposal consists of internal alterations of the and will include a demolition of drywall partitioning/shopfronts and flooring. The new construction includes drywall partitioning, shopfronts, fixtures, shopfitting, furniture and fittings. Lastly, the proposed minor work also comprises of minor upgrades of the existing ablution and kitchen facilities. These alternations will not affect or change any existing structure, brickwork, or the external façade.

Recommendations:

After scrutinising the proposed minor works plan with Ms. Smita Waghmarae and experiencing the property in loco, Block A, Longkloof Studio's, Darter Road Gardens, HWC members who undertook the site inspection noted that the proposed work has not yet started. The original fabric that gives the building a grade IIIA status has not been affected or altered. It was then agreed upon to issue the applicant with a S34 Minor Works permit in order for the work to begin.






