

The committee wanted to provide the worner with an opportunity, given the discussion, to provide detailed clarity sought on the plans and in the written report.

FINAL COMMENT:

The Committee endorses the HIA prepared by CTS Heritage dated August 2021 as meeting the requirements of the NHRA incompliance with Section 38(3) with the following recommendations on pages 40-41;

- No mitigation is required prior to construction operations commencing.
- During the construction phase, all excavations must be monitored for fossil remains by
 the responsible ECO using the HWC Chance Fossil Finds Procedure. Should substantial
 fossil remains such as vertebrate bones and teeth, petrified wood, plant-rich fossil lenses
 or dense fossil burrow assemblages be exposed during construction, the responsible
 ECO should safeguard these, preferably in situ, and alert HWC in the Western Cape so
 that appropriate action can be taken by a professional palaeontologist,
- Should any evidence of archaeological sites or remains (e.g. remnants of stone-made structures, indigenous ceramics, bones, stone artefacts, ostrich eggshell fragments, charcoal and ash concentrations), fossils or other categories of heritage resources be found during the proposed development, HWC (Colette Scheermeyer, 021 483 5959) in the Western Cape must be alerted.
- If unmarked human burials are uncovered in the Western Cape, HWC (Colette Scheermeyer, 021 483 5959) must be alerted immediately as per section 36(6) of the NHRA. A professional archaeologist must be contracted as soon as possible to inspect the findings. A Phase 2 rescue excavation operation may
- be required subject to permits issued by SAHRA and/or HWC
- The above recommendations must be included in the Environmental Management Programme (EMPr) for the project
