A. Construction Phase

The project will encompass a range of activities during the construction phase, including vegetation clearance, excavations and infrastructure development associated with the project. It is possible that cultural material will be exposed during construction and may be recoverable, keeping in mind delays can be costly during construction and as such must be minimised. Development surrounding infrastructure and construction of facilities results in significant disturbance, however, foundation holes do offer a window into the past and it thus may be possible to rescue some of the data and materials. It is also possible that substantial alterations will be implemented during this phase of the project, and these must be catered for. Temporary infrastructure developments are often changed or added to the project as required. In general, these are low impact developments as they are superficial, resulting in little alteration of the land surface, but still need to be catered for. During the construction phase, it is important to recognize any significant material being unearthed, making the correct judgment on which actions should be taken. It is recommended that the following chance find procedure should be implemented.

B. Chance Find Procedure

An appropriately qualified heritage practitioner/archaeologist must be identified to be called upon if any possible heritage resources or artefacts are identified. § Should an archaeological site or cultural material be discovered during construction (or operation), the area should be demarcated, and construction activities that may impact the find must be halted. § The qualified heritage practitioner/archaeologist will then need to determine if he/she must come out to the site and evaluate the Heritage resources and make the necessary recommendations for mitigating the find and the impact on the heritage resource. § The contractor therefore should have some sort of contingency plan so that operations could move elsewhere temporarily while the materials and data are recovered. § Construction can commence as soon as the site has been cleared and signed off by the heritage practitioner/archaeologist.

C. Possible finds during Construction

The study area occurs within a greater historical and archaeological site as identified during the desktop and fieldwork phase. Soil clearance for infrastructure as well as the proposed reclamation activities
