

EVDS Communication 26: <u>Capturing vaccines received in other countries on the Electronic Vaccine Data System (EVDS).</u>

As of 24 February 2022, the EVDS system will allow the historical back capturing of vaccines that people have receive in other countries. This communication will detail the process to follow on EVDS.


- 1. As a start, the client must register on EVDS, through the EVDS registration portal.
- 2. When the client arrives at the vaccine station, enter their EVDS profile. (please note that the profile below is fictional).



3. Once you are in the profile select Vaccination History.



- 4. This will open up the above screen. Now select add.
- 5. A pop up screen will appear. The first question is whether the client has provided proof of vaccination. The client must provide proof of having a vaccination outside South Africa. If the client is unable to provide any proof, please contact melvin.moodley@westerncape.gov.za for advice on how to proceed.
- 6. If the client does have proof of vaccination, proceed. Complete the fields. When you select vaccine, a drop down menu of the various vaccines administered around the world will appear. Select the vaccine that the client has already received.



7. Once you have completed the form, click save.



- 8. The vaccination will now be part of the client's vaccination record.
- 9. If the client requires a booster, the system will automatically calculate the booster date.
- 10. In the case where the client received their primary series of vaccines in another country, they can ONLY receive Pfizer boosters. This is based on advice by clinical advisory committees.
