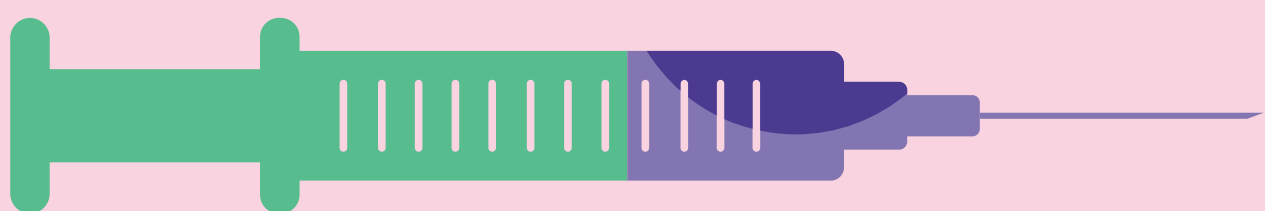


Sisonke Update

will open tomorrow.

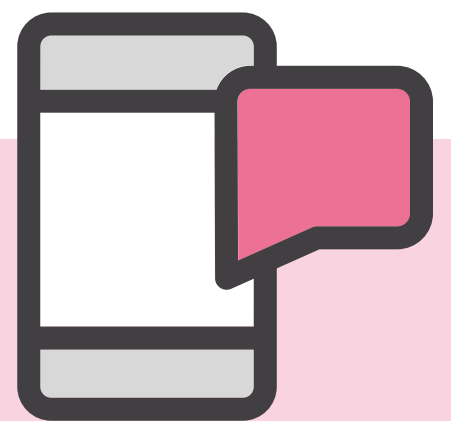


Waiting for your invite?

1

Please update us with your cell phone number if it has changed. Phone the National Coronavirus Call Centre and ask the operator to update your Vaccination Record.

If you have safety concerns or experienced a severe side-effect after the first dose you can contact the Sisonke Desk.
