MEMO: COVID VACCINE PROJECT OFFICE: DETERMINING ELIGIBILITY FOR 4TH COVID-19 VACCINE DOSE FOR IMMUNOCOMPROMISED INDIVIDUALS


From 1 December 2021 individuals with a compromised immune system were allowed (in consultation with a doctor or nurse) to register themselves on EVDS (<https://vaccine.additional.health.gov.za/#/>) for an additional dose of the Covid-19 vaccine. Once the registration was complete, they would be issued with an **Additional Dose for Immunocompromised** voucher with prefix **AD-IC-XXXXXXXXXX**. On EVDS this **AD-IC voucher** could only be redeemed using the MP/SANC number of the referring doctor or nurse.

These individuals became eligible to receive a General Booster Dose from 11 April 2022 onward, which is a 4th vaccine dose for the immunocompromised individual. These individuals received an SMS issuing them a **Booster Dose General Booster (BD-GB)** voucher. This voucher is for a General Booster Dose and thus does not require a referral letter from a doctor/nurse as is required for the Additional Dose. Once the AD-IC voucher has been redeemed, EVDS does not indicate anywhere in the vaccination history whether the 3rd dose was AD-IC or BD-GB.

If a vaccination site has doubts and wants to verify that the individual received an AD-IC voucher before, then they can go to <https://vaccine.additional.health.gov.za/#/> and search the ID number.

- If the individual received an AD-IC voucher, a message saying "Your application to Immunocompromised Persons was received on 2021-12-01 and you are already eligible for this program" will pop up. **In this instance the vaccinator may proceed to administer the 4th Covid-19 vaccine dose to the immunocompromised individual.**
- If the individual did not receive an AD-IC voucher, a message saying "Your details were found in EVDS, but you are not currently eligible for this program" will pop up. **In this instance, the individual was not registered as Immunocompromised and may not receive a 4th Covid-19 vaccine dose.**


