Parliament is hosting the State of the Nation Address by President Jacob Zuma at 19:00 on Thursday 13 February 2014. Due to this ceremony of state, motorists and pedestrians are advised of the following parking restrictions and temporary road closures between 11 February and 14 February 2014 during the following hours:

ROADS TO BE CLOSED FOR REHEARSALS BETWEEN 17H00 AND 23H59 ON 11 AND 12 FEBRUARY

- Hertzog Boulevard incoming: from Nelson Mandela Boulevard to Heerengracht
- Nelson Mandela Boulevard: Strand Street off-ramp
- Strand Street incoming: from Russel Street to Adderley Street
- Adderley Street: from Hans Strijdom Avenue to Wale Street
- Heerengracht: between Walter Sisulu and Hans Strijdom Avenues
- Bureau Street: between Adderley and Parliament Street
- Spin Street: between Corporation and Parliament Street
- Parliament Street from the gates of Parliament to Longmarket Street
