## **ERRATA TO THE 2020/21 ANNUAL PERFORMANCE PLAN**

Please note the following errata to the Annual Performance Plan of the Department of Social Development:

- Page 82 under the heading Programme Performance indicator: Number of children placed in foster care. Add to the short definition, "Newly placed include children as defined in terms of the Children's Act, 38 of 2005 who have been placed by court order into foster care as well as those where their court orders for foster care have been renewed and/or extended. It also includes persons who are over the age of 18 years and placed in foster care by extensions or renewals given in terms of section 176(2) of the Children's Act 38 of 2005."
- Page 83 under the heading Programme performance indicator: Number of children re-unified with their families or alternative caregivers. Add to the short definition, "These include children as defined in terms of the Children's Act, 38 of 2005 as well as persons who are over the age of 18 years and placed in alternate care by extensions given in terms of section 176(2) of the Children's Act 38 of 2005."
- Page 93 under the heading Programme performance indicator: Number of children in residential care in funded NPO CYCCs in terms of the Children's Act. Add to the short definition, "These include children as defined in terms of the Children's Act, 38 of 2005 as well as persons who are over the age of 18 years and placed in residential care by extensions given in terms of section 176(2) of the Children's Act, 38 of 2005."
- Page 94 under the heading Programme performance indicator: Number of children in own CYCCs in terms of the Children's Act. Add to the short definition, "These include children as defined in terms of the Children's Act, 38 of 2005 as well as persons who are over the age of 18 years and placed in residential care by extensions given in terms of section 176(2) of the Children's Act 38 of 2005."
