NOTIFICATION OF THE FUNDING MANAGEMENT PROCESS FOR 2015/16 FINANCIAL YEAR AND THEREAFTER

With reference to the Department's previous **Circular 3 of 2014 dated 15th April 2014** on the funding management process for 2015/16 financial year and thereafter.

Please take note of the following:

- 1. The purpose of the Circular is to inform the Department's service delivery partners that the NPO comprehensive call for proposals for 2015/16 financial year and thereafter are being advertised during the week of 1st June 2014 to 7th June 2014 in provincial and local newspaper publications across the Western Cape Province.
- 2. Funding is transferred to NGOs in accordance with the Department's Amended Policy on Funding of Non-Governmental Organisations (NGOs) For The Rendering Of Social Welfare as well as Community and Partnership Development Services (March 2014) as well as related policy prescripts. 3. The Process for 2015/16 financial year and thereafter is as follows:

- Attached hereby find the application package that includes the following documentation:
 - NPO Call for Proposals Advertisement: 2015/16 and thereafter
 - Supporting Documentation: Programme Specifications for services to be rendered in the Western Cape Province and eligibility criteria.
- Applications must be completed in the attached approved business plan template format only.

- All NPOs funded by the Department of Social Development need to apply (residential and non-residential facilities included) and the business plan must be completed for a three (3) year funding cycle
- The due date for submission of applications is 18th July 2014 at 16h00. Applications should ONLY be delivered via registered post (for tracking purposes) or be handed in at the DSD Western Cape Head Office in Cape Town. Emailed applications will not be accepted. Delivery details are as follows:

- All NPOs that have submitted their business plans will be acknowledged by the Department in writing on receipt of application.
- After a thorough assessment of the application, NPOs will be informed about the outcome of their application in accordance with the policy.
