CASH MANAGEMENT ARRANGEMENTS - MARCH 2014

- 1. This circular serve to inform departments of the payment release dates for the remainder of March 2014.
- 2. The manual payment release and action dates for March 2014 are reflected in Table 1.

Table 1 Manual payment release/action dates for March 2014

Release date	Period covered by the Release	Action date
20 March 2014	17 - 20 March 2014	26 March 2014
26 March 2014	24 - 26 March 2014	31 March 2014

- 3. It should be noted that the scheduled release of 31 March 2014 will depend on the availability of cash. Departments will be informed on Thursday, 27 March 2014 of their cash position after the release of 26 March 2014.
- 4. The aim of this is to ensure minimum accruals and commitments and to minimise 2013/14 expenditure utilising the cash of 2014/15.

- 5. In addition to the above dates, departments are encouraged to utilise the Beneficiary Payments (BP) functionality of Netbank Business over the period 26 31 March 2014. Departments must ensure that the Cash Management unit in the Provincial Treasury is notified of such additional payments at least two (working) days in advance to ensure sufficient funding is made available within the limits of available cash.
- 6. The signed instruction (Annexure D) for payments in excess of R5 million that was part of the release of 26 March 2014 will be processed (paid) on Friday, 28 March 2014. These instructions must reach this office by no later than Thursday, 27 March 2014.
- 7. Notwithstanding the above measures, departments must adhere to the existing Provincial Treasury's Cash Management Framework, which highlighted the importance for expenditure to remain within the available cash of the departments to the end of 31 March 2014.
- 8. It would be appreciated if these arrangements are brought to the attention of all staff dealing with cash and banking in departments.
- 9. Your co-operation in this regard would be greatly appreciated.
