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CASH MANAGEMENT MEASURES FOR MARCH 2015

1. PURPOSE

1.1 The purpose of this circular is to inform all departments of cash management arrangements for the month of March 2015.

2. CASH MANAGEMENT MEASURES: MARCH 2015

- 2.1 The measures contained herein must be considered as complimentary and supportive of all other existing policy frameworks (National & Provincial) to ensure expenditure of all votes remain within available cash as at the end of March 2015.
- 2.2 The BAS Manual Payment release and action dates for March 2015 are reflected in Table 1.

- 2.3 Provincial Parliament and all other departments will be informed, of their cash position on Friday, 27 March 2015 after the penultimate release of 26 March 2015.
- 2.4 The last scheduled release of 31 March 2015 will be subject to cash availability, coinciding with the aim of all votes to minimise accruals and commitments for 2014/15.
- 2.5 **Own Revenue**: Departments **must ensure** that own revenue is captured and authorised by Thursday, 26 March 2015 to ensure inclusion for the release of 26 March 2015.
- 2.6 **Petty Cash Accounts:** Departments **must ensure** that all Petty Cash Accounts are replenished (topped-up) by the 26 March 2015 for the latest. No debit transactions (withdrawals) must be made until **01 April 2015.**
- 2.7 The CFO's of all respective votes are requested to submit a signed confirmation to the Provincial Revenue Fund of the closing balances of all funds **outside** of the budget for 2014/15, by no later than Monday, 30 March 2015.
- 2.8 It should also be noted that the pay overs for all votes will be finalised on Tuesday 31 March 2015.
- 2.9 The transfer schedule will be disseminated to all departments daily, for the last two weeks of the month of March 2015, for reconciliation and confirmation with Provincial Revenue Fund.
- 2.10 It is utmost important that these measures are brought to the attention of all staff responsible for cash and banking in your department.
- 3. Your co-operation in this regard would be greatly appreciated.
