PROVINCIAL TREASURY GUIDELINE ON SCOA ENQUIRY PROCEDURES

THE DEPUTY DIRECTOR-GENERAL: CORPORATE ASSURANCE, DEPARTMENT OF THE PREMIER (MS H ROBSON)

#### **PURPOSE**

 To inform Accounting Officers (AOs) and Chief Financial Officers (CFOs) of departments of the procedures that need to be followed when a new SCOA Item code is requested or when guidance on the Economic Classification of transactions is required.

#### **BACKGROUND**

- 2. Section 18(2)(e) of the PFMA (Act 1 of 1999) states that a Provincial Treasury (PT) may assist provincial departments in building their capacity for efficient, effective and transparent financial management.
- 3. Provincial Treasury (PT) has continuously assisted and guided provincial departments with SCOA related queries on an informal ad-hoc basis. PT has identified the need for a formalised/structured approach to deal with SCOA matters.

#### **PROCEDURE**

- 4. PT is implementing a standardised SCOA Enquiry/Request form that must be completed by the provincial departments when requesting new SCOA item codes or when requiring guidance on the classification of transactions in terms of SCOA.
- 5. Completion of the enquiry form will provide PT with a control mechanism to effectively analyse and monitor queries received and resolved.

- 6. The following must be adhered to when requesting:
  - A new item: A definition and comprehensive motivation must be provided.
  - **Guidance**: Background information on the nature of the transaction involved must be provided.

## **REQUIRED**

- 7. SCOA Enquiries/Requests needs to be completed (Annexure A) and forwarded to PT.helpme@westerncape.gov.za.
