supplements Chapter 5 of the Ministerial Handbook and should therefore be read

in conjunction with it.

In general, Departments shall procure and manage official vehicles in

accordance with this policy framework and any rules and regulations of the

relevant department within the framework of the Public Finance Management Act

(1999) and its Regulations and prescripts.
