UTILISATION OF THE WESTERN CAPE SUPPLIER DATABASE (WCSD) AS INDICATED IN PARAGRAPH 16A2.1.3 OF THE PROVINCIAL TREASURY INSTRUCTIONS (PTI'S)

1. PURPOSE

1.1 The purpose of this document is to inform Accounting Officers, Chief Financial Officers

and Supply Chain Management line functionaries that the requirement for the exclusive

utilisation of the Western Cape Supplier Database (WCSD) is held in abeyance.

2. EXCLUSIVE UTILISATION OF THE WESTERN CAPE SUPPLIER DATABASE

2.1 Paragraph 16A2.1.3 of the Provincial Treasury Instructions issued 29 April 2008

indicates that only suppliers registered on the provincial supplier database / WCSD can

be utilised when procuring goods and services between R 10 001 and R 200 000.

2.2 This requirement will however be held in abeyance until compulsory registration for

suppliers on the Western Cape Supplier Database (WCSD) has been implemented. It is

envisaged that compulsory registration will be implemented during the third and fourth

quarters of the 2008/2009 financial year.

3. REQUEST

3.1 It is requested that Accounting Officers, Chief Financial Officers and SCM Managers

inform all relevant officials within their departments as well as institutions under their

control that:

(a) The requirement for only utilising suppliers registered on WCSD as indicated in

paragraph 16A2.1.3 of the Provincial Treasury Instructions issued 29 April

2008 be held in abeyance until further notice.
