BACKGROUND

The Provincial Treasury, Directorate Supporting and Interlinked Financial Systems is currently responsible for the co-ordination of the system. E-innovation is responsible for all departmental specific enhancements and the budget for this system is also funded by the Chief Directorate E-innovation in the Department of the Premier. Further to this the Directorate Supporting and Interlinked Financial Systems has actually no control whatsoever over the Loss Control System and losses occurred in Departments. The Loss Control System is also not a Transversal Financial System as it is only an electronic Loss Control Register.

2. PURPOSE

- 2.1 To inform Departments regarding the decentralisation of the Loss Control System.
- 2.2 It has been decided that the Loss Control System and co-ordination thereof will be decentralised to each Department with effect from 3 November 2008. As from 3 November 2008, Departments must liaise directly with the Chief Directorate E-innovation.
