ROLES AND RESPONSIBILITIES OF THE DIRECTORATE MOVEABLE ASSET MANAGEMENT UNIT OF THE PROVINCIAL TREASURY

1. PURPOSE

1.1 To inform Provincial Departments on the role and responsibility of the Directorate Moveable Asset Management unit within the Provincial Treasury as well as the areas of responsibility and contact details of the officials within the directorate.

2. BACKGROUND

- 2.1 The directorate is one of the 3 directorates that is vested under the management control of the Chief Directorate: Asset Management. The Moveable Asset Management is responsible for the oversight of supply chain management and moveable assets of provincial departments and municipalities.
- 2.2 For the purposes of this Circular the information provided is only in respect of the unit responsible for provincial departments.
- 2.3 In terms of section 18 of the PFMA, the unit's key mandate includes the following:
 - Promote and enforce transparency and effective management in respect of provincial revenue, expenditure, asset and liabilities of provincial departments;
 - Enforcement of the PFMA and any provincial norms and standards for SCM and moveable asset management;
 - Monitor and assess the implementation of national and provincial norms and standards for SCM and moveable asset management;
 - Assist and guide provincial departments in building their capacity for efficient, effective and transparent financial management in respect of SCM and moveable asset management; and
 - Investigate any system of financial management and internal control applied by provincial departments in respect of SCM and moveable asset management.

2.4 In giving effect to this mandate, the unit's responsibilities have culminated into the following:

(a) Review and guide departmental SCM and moveable asset management policy (AO system reviews);

(b) Issue and implement national and provincial SCM and moveable asset management policy; through Provincial Treasury Instructions, guidelines and practice notes;

(c) Assess departmental capacity to give effect to legislative and policy requirements, (capacity assessments, MTEC assessments, governance reviews);

(d) Provide assistance and guidance to departments as well as conduct departmental specific interventions, (training, guidance and opinions, forums);

(e) Leveraging of economies of scale and departmental bulk buying through transversal contracts; and

(f) Socio-economic imperatives, through supplier development initiatives and policy refinement.

3. ROLES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

3.1 To facilitate and best give effect to the above, the unit's following individuals have been tasked with the areas of responsibilities for the 2009 / 10 financial year as encapsulated in the attached **Annexure A**.

3.2 Areas of responsibilities will be reviewed annually or when the need arises.
