APPOINTMENT OF AUDIT COMMITTEE MEMBERS - RESTRUCTURED AUDIT COMMITTEES

PURPOSE

The purpose of this circular is to commence the process of the selection and appointment of audit committee members.

2. BACKGROUND

Cabinet Minute 55/ 2007, dated 28 February 2007, approved the further roll-out, internal capacitation and re-organising of Internal Audit in PGWC. It further approved the establishment of audit committees to complement the restructured Internal Audit function as follows,

- Transport & Public Works
- Social Development, Cultural Affairs & Sport and Community Safety
- Environmental Affairs and Development Planning, Agriculture and Economic Development and Tourism
- Department of the Premier, Local Government and Housing, Provincial Treasury and Western Cape Provincial Parliament

3. LEGISLATIVE BACKGROUND

In terms of S38(1)(a)(ii) of the PFMA, the accounting officer for a department must ensure that the department has and maintains a system of internal audit under the control and direction of an audit committee complying with and operating in accordance with regulations and instructions prescribed in terms of Section 76 and 77 of the PFMA. A preparation pack containing other relevant legislation and the audit committee charter will be provided to the selection committee to assist in guiding the process.

4. APPLICATIONS

The Provincial Treasury has invited applications for the appointment of audit committee members. These CV's will be included in the above-mentioned preparation pack.

5. LOGISTICAL ARRANGEMENTS

The Committee Co-ordinators will arrange a suitable date for the responsible Heads of Department to meet in order to finalize shortlisting and the interview process. The

committee co-ordinators will schedule the necessary interviews and make the necessary logistical arrangements as directed by the selection committee. Once the selection of members has been finalized, the nominations, together with a short motivation in favour of the selected candidates should be forwarded to the Ms R. Jaftha at the Provincial Treasury. A submission will then be prepared to seek approval for the appointments from the Head: Provincial Treasury as stated in Chapter 3.1.3 of the National Treasury Regulations.

The appointment of the members of the audit committee for the department of Transport & Public Works will be done in terms of Chapter 3.1.2 of the National Treasury Regulations.

Your co-operation in this regard is highly valued.
