- 1. I refer to Treasury Circular No. 3 2006 dated 7 January 2006, in which the LG MTEC 2 process was communicated to you.
- 2. During the LG MTEC 2 engagements a request was made to all transferring provincial departments making transfers to municipalities over the 2006/07 MTEF to finalise the said transfers (frameworks and amounts) as soon as possible and submit it with the BS 2's on Friday, 3 February 2006. After processing these transfers it would be made available informally to receiving municipalities to enable them to include it in their respective 2006/07 draft budgets. Municipalities were requested to fast track their own budgets processes in view of the imminent local government elections on 1 March 2006.

- 3. The intention is, as was done this financial year (2005/06), to table the transfers to municipalities with the main budget on 17 February 2006. Upon tabling, the transfers to municipalities would be formally communicated.
