### 2006/07: CASH FLOW MANAGEMENT

## 1. Purpose

- 1.1 To inform Accounting Officers of the tighter cash flow management that will be applicable for the remainder of the current financial year and measures implemented in this regard.
- 2. Cash flow projections and prevention of March spike:
- 2.1 <u>Cash Flow projections</u>
- 2.1.1 Accounting Officers are afforded the opportunity to re-examine their cash flow projections for the remainder of the current financial year (January to March 2007) and where necessary, revise the cash flow projections, in mitigation of the March spike.
- 2.1.2 The Provincial Treasury will regard the revised cash flow projections for the remainder of the current financial year as the new monthly cash flow requirements of departments.
- 2.1.3 Only in exceptional cases and only after receipt of a written motivation, indicating the reasons for the deviation (over or under) and steps implemented to prevent a re-occurrence, will consideration be given to the further revision of the cash flow projections.
- 2.1.4 The revised cash flow projections must reach this office by no later than 22 December 2006, for attention Ms Denise Coetzee at <a href="mailto:dcoetzee@pgwc.gov.za">dcoetzee@pgwc.gov.za</a> or fax number 021-483 8623.
- 2.2 Authorisation for payments in excess of R500 000,00
- 2.2.1 In terms of Treasury Circular 28/2001, you are once again reminded that prior authorisation must be obtained from the Provincial Treasury for all payments exceeding R500 000.
- 2.2.2 To further improve effective cash flow management and to ensure that payments are only made when they are due, that services have been rendered and that the expenditure has been budgeted for, the following measures are implemented with immediate effect:
- 2.2.2.1 The attached "authorisation for payments in excess of R500 000" form has been developed for completion by departments for the remainder of the current financial year.
- 2.2.2.2 The completed form must be forwarded to the Financial Asset Management component within the Provincial Treasury 48 hours prior to authorisation being sought. The completed form will be forwarded to the relevant components within PT for verification prior to the issuing of an authority number, where applicable.
- 3. Your cooperation to ensure more effective cash flow management will be greatly appreciated.
