ASSET MANAGEMENT GUIDELINES (MOVABLE ASSETS)

1. Purpose

To inform Accounting Officers, Chief Financial Officers and Asset Managers within the Western Cape Provincial Government of the issuing of Asset Management Guidelines to the drawing-up of different Asset Management Plans.

2. Background

Following the Asset Management Review initiative driven by National Treasury, Provincial Departments were required to draw-up project plans to which they will be held in meeting certain milestones associated with the initiative.

These milestones included the existence of a credible asset register conforming to certain prescribed minimum requirements.

Among these minimum requirements was the existence of a variety of asset plans covering acquisition, operation & maintenance as well as the disposal of assets.

Following a series of workshops and consensus seeking engagements, the attached is produced as a final guide to departments in the process of drawing up their own departmental plans.

As per agreement, this is meant to be a phased roll-out and for this phase, it will not be expected of departments to produce Operations & Maintenance plans until the funding issue is adequately resolved.

These plans will also be utilized, in future, in the determination of departmental budget allocations.

Provincial Departments are requested to adjust their implementation plans, failure to do that would mean departments would be assessed against the National Treasury broad implementation plan.
