- Turnout rate of 70% or more in all learning areas.
- Pass rates of 80% or more in 3 learning areas (minimum) and above 70% pass rates in the rest of the learning areas (to a maximum of 6 learning areas overall)
- Consistency in numbers registered from 2008 to 2010.

Maximum of 3 awards to Public centres and 1 from partners of the WCED, including DCS and City of Cape Town:
