RE: ASSET MANAGEMENT AND SUPPLY CHAIN MANAGEMENT TRAINING

1. PURPOSE

- 1.1 To inform the Departments about the Moveable Asset Management's intention to streamline the content of the courses that will be offered as per Provincial Treasury Circular 14/2011 and to decide on who is suitable to attend the courses.
- 1.2 To further inform the Departments about the Moveable Asset Management's intention to assess the effectiveness of the training by means of tests.

2. BACKGROUND

- 2.1 The Moveable Asset Management unit of the Western Cape Provincial Treasury is on a quest to improve its training interventions by offering training that will speak to the challenges of the Departments.
- 2.2 These challenges will be identified by scrutinizing the Virtuous Cycle Assessment reports; Auditor General's reports; and the query register.
- 2.3 The Moveable Asset Management unit will be targeting specific officials to attend its training interventions. This is meant to ensure that the individuals that need special intervention are capacitated as the course material will be pitched at levels suitable to the targeted audiences.
- 2.4 The targeted audiences for the above training are officials working in the Bid section and remunerated on level 6 and upwards.
- 2.5 The effectiveness of the training will be measured by means of written assessments after the training. These assessments will enable us to gauge the trainee's level of understanding and its outcome will trigger possible future interventions.
