# ACCOUNTING STANDARDS BOARD (ASB) – TRANSITIONAL PROVISIONS FOR INITIAL ADOPTION OF GRAP 104 FINANCIAL INSTRUMENTS (EXPOSURE DRAFT 81)

#### Purpose

 The purpose of this circular is to obtain comments in writing pertaining to the proposed transitional provisions for the initial adoption of GRAP 104: Financial Instruments contained in Exposure Draft 81.

### Background

- 2. The Standard of GRAP on Financial Instruments (GRAP 104) was approved by the Accounting Standards Board (the Board) as a final Standard of GRAP in July 2009.
- 3. The Board needs to develop transitional provisions to assist entities with the initial adoption of this Standard, and once approved by the Board, the transitional provisions for GRAP 104 will be included in Directives 2 to 4 and 8.
- 4. Prior to the adoption of GRAP 104, entities have been required to apply IAS 32 Financial Instruments: Presentation, IAS 39 Financial Instruments: Recognition and Measurement and IFRS 7 on Financial Instruments as part of the GRAP Reporting Framework.
- Entities should have recognized, measured and disclosed financial instruments using the relevant IFRS, and thus the transitional provisions have been developed to focus on the areas where GRAP 104 and the IFRS differ.

## Action required

- 7. The Board seeks comment on the proposals set out in the Exposure Draft from preparers, users, auditors, standard-setters and other parties with an interest in public sector financial reporting.
- 8.
