BASIC ACCOUNTING HANDBOOK FOR GOVERNMENT DEPARTMENTS

PURPOSE

 This Circular serves to draw the attention of all Accounting Officers (AOs) and Chief Financial Officers (CFOs) to the Basic Accounting Handbook (BAH) as issued by the National Treasury.

BACKGROUND

- 2. The BAH was issued by the National Treasury (Office of the Accountant General) during August 2010 as a guide to departments on the accurate recording of financial transactions. It provides guidance on accounting as well as business processes to ensure that transactions are correctly recorded in terms of the SCOA and financial systems rules. In the BAH, accounting principles and transactions have been documented as it is also currently covered in the Departmental Financial Reporting Guide (formerly known as the Preparation Guide on Annual Financial Statements). In future it is envisaged that all accounting principles and guidance will be covered in the BAH and all financial reporting guidance in the Departmental Financial Reporting Guide.
- 3. The purpose and content of the BAH was discussed at the AFS Workshop held on 26 October 2010 and attendees were informed of the change in approach as highlighted in paragraph 2 above.

REQUEST

- 4. Please encourage all relevant officials to study the content of the BAH and ensure that they remain abreast with any updates. A recommended prerequisite to the BAH would be the attendance of SCOA courses presented by PALAMA as well as functional training courses on transversal systems offered by the Provincial Treasury.
- 5. You are kindly requested to distribute this Circular and the BAH (see attached) to all officials involved with financial management and reporting.
