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GOVERNMENT MOTOR TRANSPORT (GMT): WESTERN CAPE: ANNUAL ADJUSTMENT IN THE KILOMETER AND DAILY TARIFFS (2011/12)

1. Purpose

MASTER RECORDS OFFICIAL: FINANCIAL MANAGEMENT

This circular serves to communicate the revision of the Government Motor Transport Kilometre and Daily tariffs for 2011/12 to Departments.

2. Discussion

Provincial Treasury has granted approval for the 2011/12 Daily and Kilometre tariffs to be increased with 3.5 per cent (CPI rate for December 2010) for all clients of GMT (provincial and national) with effect from 1 April 2011.

Accounting Officers and Chief Financial Officers are kindly requested to make provision for a 3.5 per cent increase in their budget for 2011/12 for GMT costs. Given that the GMT Business Model will be reviewed this year, departments are requested in the interim to budget 5.1 per cent for 2012/13 and 5.2 per cent for 2013/14 (National Treasury's Headline CPI inflation projections).

Departments should please note that the GMT in concert with Provincial Treasury is in the process of developing a new Business Model. Departments are welcome to provide inputs/suggestions/proposals that would assist in developing a new GMT Business Model to both the GMT and Provincial Treasury.

3. Action required

Accounting Officers and Chief Financial Officers to note the 3.5 per cent increase (effective 1 April 2011) in the GMT tariffs for 2011/12 and that Departments and Public Entities should provide the necessary budgetary requirements.
