# RE: SUPPLY CHAIN MANAGEMENT (SCM) TRAINING

#### 1. PURPOSE

1.1 To inform departments that the Provincial Treasury, Directorate: Moveable Asset Management will provide SCM training over the period 3 February 2012 – 2 March 2012, as well as to inform departments of the logistical arrangements regarding the training.

#### 2. BACKGROUND

- As a result of the upgrade and refinement of the e-procurement solution for quotations (EPSi), the requirement of compulsory registration on the WCSD, the revised Preferential Procurement Regulations (PPR) 2011 as well as the Interim Provincial Treasury Instructions (PTI's) issued via PT Circular 63 of 2011, it has become necessary to provide SCM training that cover the various requirements emanating from these developments.
- 2.2 The Provincial Treasury in collaboration with certain departmental officials has arranged training on the revised PPR, 2011 in the form of roadshows for suppliers and officials involved in the day to day operations of SCM. Training has therefore been arranged in an endeavour to provide ongoing assistance/training to departments.

### 3. LOGISTICAL ARRANGEMENTS

- 3.1 The training will take place at the Department of the Premier's CEI lab, 3<sup>rd</sup> Floor, 9 Riebeeck Street, Cape Town.
- 3.2 The following training sessions have been scheduled:
  - a) 10 FEBRUARY 2012: 8H30-13H00
  - b) 17 FEBRUARY 2012: 8H30-13H00
  - c) 24 FEBRUARY 2012: 8H30-13H00
  - d) 09 MARCH 2012: 8H30-13H00

- 3.3 The content of the training sessions will be as follows:
  - a) EPSi (upgrade and refinement);
  - b) Requirements of compulsory registration (WCSD);
  - c) Preferential Procurement Regulations 2011;
  - d) Interim PTI's; and
  - e) NT instruction Note on enhancing compliance, monitoring and improving transparency and accountability in SCM.
- 3.4 The EPSi (upgrade and refinement) as well as the requirements of compulsory registration on the WCSD as tabled above will be facilitated by Quadrem via live connectivity.

#### 4. REQUEST

- 4.1 There are 15 notebooks available at the venue and the Departments are therefore requested to nominate a maximum of 4 officials per department.
