RE: EVALUATION OF THE SUPPLY CHAIN MANAGEMENT HELPDESK FUNCTION

1. PURPOSE

1.1 To ascertain from provincial departments and provincial public entities if the supply chain management helpdesk function, provided by the Provincial Treasury, directorate: Moveable Asset Management, is effective and if it is meeting the objective of building capacity within supply chain management in provincial departments and provincial public entities.

2. BACKGROUND

- 2.1 In terms of section 18 (e) of the PFMA (Act 1 of 1999), a Provincial Treasury may assist provincial departments and provincial public entities in building their capacity for efficient, effective and transparent financial management.
- 2.2 In meeting this requirement, a Helpdesk Framework was developed to support the existing query log/register. A dedicated e-mail address was created to enable efficiency gains and the management of queries.
- 2.3 On 1 November 2010, the SCM Helpdesk was implemented to formally monitor grievances, complaints and request for opinions from provincial departments and suppliers / contractors. The implementation of the Framework was communicated via PT Circular 47 of 2010 and 10 of 2011. The SCM helpdesk gives provincial departments, public entities and suppliers the opportunity to log their SCM related queries and request opinions from Provincial Treasury.
- 2.4 The directorate: Moveable Asset Management is seeking to evaluate how it can improve on its mandate of guiding and assisting provincial departments and provincial public entities and as such would like to find out from the users of the helpdesk how it can improve on the delivery of the service.
