REGISTRATION OF USERS ONTO THE NEW CONTRACT REGISTRATION APPLICATION SYSTEM (CRA) PREVIOUSLY PCI SYSTEM IN RESPECT OF THE NEW PREFERENTIAL PROCUREMENT REGULATIONS, 2011

1 Purpose

- 1.1 The purpose of this communiqué is to disseminate the attached National Treasury letter (included as annexure "A") informing all Provincial Departments of the new reporting system called Contract Registration Application (CRA) previously known as the Procurement Contract Information (PCI) system, as this system has been amended to be consistent with the requirements of the revised Preferential Procurement Regulations, 2011.
- 1.2 To inform all Provincial Departments of the new registration processes and requirements of users to obtain access to the system when reporting on contracts awarded above the threshold of R100 000.

2. Request

- 2.1 The Provincial Treasury therefore requests that:
- a) All Accounting Officers ensures that the content of this circular is brought to the attention of all relevant officials within their departments.

b) Departments nominate three (3) officials within their SCM units for registration and training purposes on the CRA system. It is imperative that one of the nominated officials

be the data capturer that is familiar with contract award reporting requirements.

SUBJECT: REGISTRATION OF USERS ONTO THE CONTRACT REGISTRATION APPLICATION (CRA) AS A RESULT OF THE REVISED PREFERENTIAL PROCUREMENT REGULATIONS, 2011 THAT CAME INTO EFFECT ON 7 DECEMBER 2011.

- The Norms and Standards Unit within the Specialist Functions Branch of the National Treasury is, among others, vested with the responsibility of monitoring the award of contracts above the value of R100 000.00. The system for reporting such contracts must be in accordance with the applicable legislative framework governing awarding of public sector contracts.
- The purpose of this letter is to seek the assistance of your Office with the registration of users onto the Contract Registration Application (CRA) (previously known as the Procurement Contract Information (PCI) system). The system which is being used for reporting purposes has been amended to be consistent with the requirements of the revised Preferential Procurement Regulations, 2001 which came into effect on 7 December 2011.
- Provincial departments are, therefore, required to nominate at least 3 officials within their Supply Chain Management Units for registration and training purposes. It is imperative that at least one of the nominated officials should be a data capturer that is familiar with the contract award reporting requirements.
- It would be appreciated if you would obtain the following information / details in respect of the officials from the various Departments in your Province and submit same to the National Treasury:
 - Full names of the users;
 - Name of Department;
 - · Assigned profiles i.e. contract capturer, approver, system manager,
 - · E-mail addresses; and
 - Persal / employee numbers.

- 5 Departments are required to report all the outstanding awarded contracts in terms of the previous Preferential Procurement Regulations, 2001 manually because amended online contract reporting system will only accommodate the contracts awarded on the Revised PPPFA regulation of 2011, where information in respect of respect of the contractors B-BBEE Level of Contribution.
- 6 The information required in paragraph 4 above must be sent to the National Treasury e-mail jerry.maluleke@treasury.gov.za to khutso.mashabela@treasury.gov.za by no later than 17 February 2012.
