IMPROVING FIRE PREVENTION THROUGH CAUSE DETERMINATION

If the cause of a fire is known, there is an increased chance of preventing future fires of a similar nature, as well as having information to confront and convict suspects in cases of malicious acts

Through the implementation of proper techniques and procedures by qualified and experienced investigators, it is possible in about 90% of cases to accurately determine the cause of a veldfire





It is concerning that numerous fire managers often do not believe that the origin and cause, especially for large fires, can be determined. And even if the cause is able to be determined, the culprit will never be caught.



TWO OF THE MAJOR FACTORS THAT HINDER A SUCCESSFUL **INVESTIGATION ARE: 1. NOT REQUESTING ONE AT AN** EARLY STAGE, AND **2. FIRE FIGHTERS DAMAGING** THE GENERAL ORIGIN

THREE EXAMPLES WHERE THE CAUSE OF VELDFIRES WERE INCORRECTLY DETERMINED BY FIRST RESPONDERS

EXAMPLE 1

Location: Red Hill Rd, South Peninsula. January 2009

Approx. time of ignition: 02h30

Reported cause by responders: Accidental discarding of cigarette

Actual cause: Malicious. Handheld flare



EXAMPLE 2

Location: Plateau Rd, South Peninsula. February 2009

Approx. time of ignition: 00h30

Reported cause by responders: Accidental discarding of cigarette

Actual cause: Malicious. Book matches



EXAMPLE 3

Location: Close to Smitswinkel Bay, South Peninsula. February 2013

Approx. time of ignition: 06h00

Reported cause by responders: Homeless people in the bushes

Actual cause: Fireworks



IN THE CAPE PENINSULA, THE GENERAL CAUSES OF VELDFIRES ARE :

- Approx 30% : Homeless people
- Approx 30% : Children
- Approx 30% : Improperly extinguished fires
- 10% : Accidental & malicious

Closing statements

- 1. Unless the true causes of fires are determined, costly efforts will continue to be misdirected and wasted. An examples is the assumption that cigarettes are causing most roadside fires.
- 2. I say with confidence that the majority of veldfires in the Cape Peninsula that start after 18h30 are not accidental cigarette ignitions. This is based on studies being undertaken and investigations to date. Unless these fires are properly investigated and evidence collected, whoever is setting them will continue to do so without being caught.

3. It is strongly recommended that fire perimeters be checked with a low-cost digital thermometer to locate possible hidden embers so as to avoid re-kindled fires. Enviro Wildfire Services would be happy to provide these to Fish Hoek, Simonstown and Lakeside fire stations as we have with simplex two-way radios.

4. It is proposed that the matter of homeless people and woodcutters that use open fires on the urban edge be addressed.

5. If more veldfire "cause investigations" were undertaken by qualified and experienced investigators, it would be possible to:

- a) Improve fire prevention by identifying the true causes of the fires, and
- b) Increase the chances of apprehending those that are maliciously setting them
