HOW TO BE A SUPPLIER TO GOVERNMENT

Each sphere of government has its own regulations and rules regarding the purchase of goods and services from suppliers and businesses.

For the Provincial Government of the Western Cape, there are 3 categories:

- 1. Tenders under R10 000.00, are sourced telephonically from potential suppliers. For more information, to register as a supplier, call the individual department or the Department of Economic Development and Tourism on 021 483 9114
- 2. Tenders above R10 000.00 and below R200 000.00 are managed by Tradeworld. Service providers need to register on the database by calling 021-6804600 (or visit www.tradeworld.co.za)
- 3. Tenders with a value greater then R200 000.00 are advertised in the local and national newspapers, the Government Tender Bulletin and on www.capegateway.gov.za

For the City of Cape Town, the following three categories apply:

- 1. Tenders under R30 000.00 are sourced from the Community Suppliers Database. To register call 021 400 3618
- 2. Tenders above R30 000.00 and below R200 000.00 are advertised on the website www.capetown.gov.za
- 3. Tenders greater than R200 000.00 are advertised weekly in the Cape Times and Die Burger on Fridays, and on the website www.capetown.gov.za
