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## THE AFTER SCHOOL GAME CHANGER ARTS PRACTITIONER TRAINING PROGRAMME

This is a one-year part-time programme for in-service After School Practitioners that aims to support them in delivering quality arts engagements to school going learners, with a focus on theatre/drama and dance. The programme is supported by the Western Cape Government After School Game Changer, and is aimed at arts coaches working in after school programmes across the province.

This year the programme will have particular focus on the Cape Metro, Cape Winelands and the Eden region. 60 practitioners will be selected to join the training programme from across these three regions.

Please note that if selected it is compulsory for participants to attend the following:

- Information meeting and workshop at one of the three venues listed above
- 4 days intensive skills development training from 25<sup>th</sup>-29<sup>th</sup> March
- All 4 Community of Practice Meetings (COPs)
- Have their learners perform in a regional arts/community showcase
