

Reason for Site Inspection:

Heritage Western Cape (HWC) was informed on the 6th of April about the unauthorised work that took place on site. The site is located within a Heritage Protected Overlay Zone and graded a potential IIIC Erfenis Wes-Kaap according to the City Map viewer. An application in terms of Section 34 of the National Heritage Resource Act was not submitted to HWC to process and permit the work which took place on site.

Mr. Tim Dunn who represents the complainant and owners of Erf 2909, 13 Bryant Street, Bo Kaap, Cape Town (the neighbour) filed a report to the City of Cape Town (CoCT) as well as HWC illustrating and elaborating the unlawful construction of a deck on the roof on 47 Upper Pepper Street, Bo-Kaap. In summary, the representative states that the deck is not a mere inconsequential feature and covers almost the entire existing roof of 47 Upper Pepper Street. Further to this, it is predominantly physically attached to the wall of property of 13 Bryant Street, without the slightest knowledge, let alone consent, of his client.

It is also apparent that, aside from being attached to the wall of the client's property, the decking and new roof is not properly attached to much else. There are also various concerns (noted in the report) regarding the structure in terms of procedure, legalities and primarily, the deck being attached to porous clay brick wall of the client's 99-year-old heritage house.

Findings and Discussion:

Upon visiting the site and trying to contact the owner of 47 Upper Pepper Street, Bo-Kaap, no access has been granted on the day to assess the severity and damage of the structure erected by the owner without any application or plans submitted to HWC.

As seen in the images attached below, the structure does cover the roof area of the property and supported by the wall of the neighbouring property for stability. HWC officials noted additionally as well as externally, other work occurring on site which have not been acknowledged by HWC.

Recommendations:

On the 19th of April, a follow-up call was made and the owner acknowledged (telephonically) that she received the Stop Works order issued by HWC and will request her architect to liaise further with regards to the HWC application process as well as grant officials access to the site in order to assess the heritage resources that have been impacted upon and if any charges should be laid for the illegal/unauthroused work taking place on site.

Reason for Site Inspection:

Heritage Western Cape(HWC) was informed on the 16th of March about the unauthorised work that took place (and currently still taking place) on site. The site is located within a Heritage Protected Overlay Zone and graded IIIB. An application in terms of Section 34 of the National Heritage Resource Act was not submitted to HWC to process and permit the additions and alterations which took place/taking place on site. The heritage officer, hence, undertook a site inspection and was met on site by the site manager (Riedwaan) who accepted the stop works order issued in terms of Section 23 relating to "an activity taking place on the property cited above, and there is reasonable cause to believe this contravenes Section 34 of the Act and which may destroy, damage or alter the heritage resource".

The owner of the property has since contacted the heritage officer to specify the work undertaken and reason behind the replacement of the original cast-iron fencing (completed) as well as internal alterations and maintenance on site (in progress). The officer has informed the owner that work cannot continue until HWC receives the application and the matter is heard and concluded by our committee before continuing with the rest of the work.

Findings and Discussion:

It is evident upon visiting the site that the cast-iron fencing has been replaced with wooden fencing. According to the site manager, it has been replaced way before they have been called to commence with the alterations and maintenance on site i.e., painting, refurbishment, alterations etc.) Further to this, the owner has indicated that parts of the cast-iron fence were stolen hence having to replace the fence entirely for the sake of security purposes.

Recommendations:

The owner has agreed to submit an application to HWC which in turn needs to be acknowledged and tabled at the Heritage Officers' Meeting in order to provide the owner/applicant with a decision before work can continue.






Figure 3 & 4- Wooden fencing replacement
