CALL FOR NOMINATIONS OF MEMBERS OF THE PUBLIC TO SERVE ON THE COMMITTEES OF HERITAGE WESTERN CAPE

Members of the public are invited to nominate candidates who could serve on the committees of Heritage Western Cape for a **three-year period, from 1 February 2023 to 31 January 2026**. Heritage Western Cape is a provincial heritage resources authority with the responsibilities of identifying, protecting, conserving, managing, and promoting the heritage resources of the province. Its mandate is derived from the National Heritage Resources Act, Act No. 25 of 1999.

The committees of Heritage Western Cape are:

- Archaeology, Palaeontology and Meteorites Committee (APM)
- Built environment and Landscapes (BelCom)
- Impact Assessment Committee (IACom)
- Inventories, Gradings and Interpretations Committee (IGIC)
- Appeals Committee

REQUIREMENTS:

Nominees are required to:

- a) be permanent residents of the Western Cape
- b) have knowledge of and qualifications, experience or interest in subjects relating to heritage resources management

Members of the committees will be appointed by the Council according with principles of transparency and representativity of the heritage of the people of the Western Cape.

The closing date for nominations is 15 January 2023.
