CALL FOR COMMENT ON THE PROPOSED HERITAGE WESTERN CAPE FEE STRUCTURE

Heritage Western Cape is a provincial heritage resources authority established in terms of Section 23 of the National Heritage Resources Act No.25 of 1999 (NHRA) and Provincial Notice 336 of 25 October 2002.

In line with practice by other heritage authorities, the Council of Heritage Western Cape is considering the reviewing of charges levied for applications made to it in terms of the National Heritage Resources Act. Powers to do so are set out in Sections 25(l)(l)(i) and 48(l)(a) of the Act.
