HOW TO MAKE A NOMINATION

Background

The Department of Cultural Affairs and Sport seeks to recognise outstanding achievements and contributions in the fields of after-school arts, culture and sport coaching; archives; arts, culture and literature; geographical names; heritage; language; libraries and museums in the Western Cape for the 2017/18 financial year.

The awards are open to individuals, organisations and groups whose efforts have made a difference in the province's communities. The department seeks to honour those whose work contributes to strengthening the platform upon which the Western Cape can position itself as a creative and innovative centre of excellence.

Transversal Adjudication Criteria

The adjudication criteria below will be transversally used to evaluate all nominations, and thereafter followed by sector-specific criteria:

- Community impact and development the extent to which the nominee has proven measurable and impactful results that demonstrate social inclusivity and enhanced awareness
- Innovation the extent to which the nominee has been innovative and creative in his/her approach to activities in their field
- Talent identification the extent to which the nominee identifies and develops talent
- Targeting of high priority focus areas the extent to which the nominee addresses such issues as:
 - job creation
 - youth at risk
 - skills transfer
 - training

- increased use of sector services or
- audience development in a genre.
- Youth development, nation building and women's empowerment the extent to which the nominee integrates these strategic focus areas in their area of expertise
- **Technical and creative aspects** the extent to which the nominee reflects technical aptitude and creativity within their area of expertise.

Nomination requirements

- Nominees or their projects must reside and be based in the Western Cape.
- Award nominations must be submitted on the attached form.
- Each award nomination must be submitted on a separate form.
- Nominations must be accompanied by a one-page written motivation as well as documentary evidence for the project.
- The awards issued only pertain to projects implemented during the 2017/18 financial year (for the period April 2017 to March 2018).
- Award nominations must be received by the Department no later than **30 September 2018**.

Adjudication of awards

- A panel of experts will evaluate every nomination and make recommendations accordingly.
- The Department will advise award winners suitably ahead of the official awards ceremony.
- Winners will be publicly announced and honoured at the awards ceremony.
- No documentation will be returned.
- The decision of the selection panel is final, and no discussion or correspondence will be entered into.
