CALL FOR FUNDING APPLICATIONS (PROPOSALS) TO RENDER CERTAIN YOUTH DEVELOPMENT SERVICES IN THE WESTERN CAPE FOR 2017-2018 FINANCIAL YEAR AND THEREAFTER

Funding applications are invited from Non Profit and other qualifying organisations to render youth targeted developmental interventions/services on behalf of the Department. This includes the following.

- A. Set-up and the management of YOUTH CAFÉS and related services in the following areas in the Western Cape:**
- **Cape Winelands/Overberg** : Villiersdorp
 - **West Coast**: Vredenburg (Velddrift)
 - **Eden Karoo**: Mossel Bay (Great Brak River)
- B. Provision of high quality services and support to new and existing youth cafes across the province:**
- **Eden Karoo**: George, Uniondale, Oudtshoorn and Mossel Bay Municipal areas
 - **Metro South**: Mitchells Plain, Gugulethu, Retreat and Wynberg SDA's
 - **West Coast**: Vredenburg
 - **Cape Winelands/Overberg**: Bredasdorp, Worcester and Swellendam
 - **Metro North**: Atlantis
- C. Integrated youth developmental interventions/services in the following Western Cape areas:**
- **Cape Winelands/Overberg**: Barrydale, Bonnievale and Kleinmond
 - **Metro East**: Scottsville, Kraaifontein, Khayelitsha, Mfuleni, Somerset West and Strand
 - **Metro North**: Delft, Atlantis, Elsiesriver, Du Noon and Joe Slovo
 - **Eden Karoo**: Laingsburg, Beaufort West and Murraysburg
 - **West Coast**: Vredendal and Vredenburg

Please note that only the correct 2017-18 funding application forms obtained from the Department of Social Development must be used.

Basic Eligibility Criteria and Conditions Applicable to Funding Applications:

- Be registered in terms of the NPO Act 71 of 1997 or Item 1 of Schedule 1 of the Companies Act 71 of 2008;

- The above—mentioned registrations must be current and proof of validity must be included in the funding application (i.e. deregistered organisations will automatically be disqualified);
- Proven track record of rendering of community and youth development services within the RSA
- Demonstrated expertise, experience and competence to implement high quality programmes for young people.
- As per the application forms clear targets, outputs and outcomes must be reflected in funding applications, which must be aligned to the Annual Performance Plan of the Department, Western Cape Youth Development Strategy and DSD Youth Development Strategy
- Funding applications must further include audited or certified financial statements of the applicant organisation in respect of the previous financial year;
- Funding applications must include indication by the applicant organisation of its internal monitoring and evaluation mechanisms and specifically declare its willingness to adhere to the Department's timelines for reporting on results;
- Funding applications will be considered in accordance with the Western Cape Government's Department of Social Development's funding policy for NPOs. (which can be accessed via http://www.westerncape.gov.za/sites/www.westerncape.gov.za/files/dsd_policy_on_funding_of_ngos_march_2014.pdf)
