Never cross a free-way, always use a pedestrian bridge or a subway.



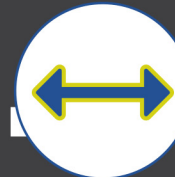
Be alert when you are near parked cars. They may start moving.



Always make eye contact with drivers when crossing streets.



Look right, left, and right again before crossing a street. Keep watching as you cross.

PEDESTRIAN SAFETY



Find the safest place to cross a road. Use subways, traffic lights, footbridges and zebra crossings if possible. Crossing points controlled by police, traffic officers and school traffic assistants and school patrols are also safe.

Don't use your cell phone, your earphones or your headphones when you cross a road.



Cross streets at a corner, using traffic signals and crossing. Remember that drivers might not wait for you to cross.



Even if you are crossing at a safe place, remember that drivers may not stop when they should. Look before you cross the road.



Cross at a place where you can see clearly in all directions, and where drivers can see you.



Always walk on the pavement. If there is no pavement, walk on the edge of the road where you can face oncoming traffic.



Wear bright colours or reflective clothing if you are walking near traffic at night.
