In terms of Regulation 21(6)(c) and (d) of the National Land Transport Regulations (2009), an operating licence must not be issued unless the operator has produces to the PRE proof of compliance of any condition imposed by the entity / proof of certification of any matter required by the entity. Section 62 (1)(g) of the NLTA stipulates that an operating licence may only be issued if the applicant has submitted any other proof, information or document as prescribed or required by the applicant.
