



FULL-TIME STUDY BURSARIES FOR 2015

The Western Cape Provincial Treasury invites matriculants, undergraduate and postgraduate students interested in pursuing a career in any of the following fields to apply for bursaries:

- Economics • Accounting • Finance • Asset Management • Built Environment • Internal Auditing • Supply Chain Management
- Information Systems • Information Management

Note: Bursaries will be awarded to successful applicants to study full-time towards accredited courses at accredited universities in the identified study fields/scarce skills, for a period not less than one (1) and not more than three (3) years. Successful applicants will be required to enter into contractual agreements with the Provincial Treasury. Applicants with disabilities are welcome to apply.

Minimum requirements:

- Applicants must be South African, aged 17 to 35 years and residing in the Western Cape • A minimum level of 55% or higher in at least two of the subjects Economics, Mathematics and Accounting at high school (pupils currently in grade 12 should please submit results for December 2013 and June 2014) and an average of 60% or higher at university or technicon
- Postgraduate applicants should already have obtained a B. Degree within one or more of the fields indicated above • Must not be in possession of another bursary • Preference will be given to disadvantaged candidates.
