CRITERIA FOR NOMINATIONS

1. Nominees should be at least 55 years old.
2. People who contributed to advancing equality, inclusivity or diversity in their sport and recreation.
3. People who made a significant contribution to sport and recreation:
 - Athletes who set records, achieved historic milestones or represented their country at international events.
 - Coaches or mentors who developed innovative techniques or strategies that changed the way their sport is played.
 - Administrators who pioneered organisational reforms, increased participation or improved the infrastructure and accessibility of sport.
4. People who significantly contributed to the advancement of disability sport, women and girls and other spheres of sport and recreation.
5. People who are regarded as sport icons in their communities:
 - Administrators, athletes, coaches or mentors or those who have built programmes or initiatives to uplift disadvantaged or marginalised communities.
 - Nominees who are known for their community development initiatives, volunteer work or contribution to charitable causes outside their competitive arena within sport and recreation.
6. People who have committed their lives to contribute to sport and recreation:
 - Those who continued to contribute to their sport even after retirement, through mentoring, coaching or administration.
 - Individuals who handled victories and defeats with dignity, setting a moral example for younger generations.
