WHAT IS THE TRAVELLING ARCHIVE?

The Western Cape Archives contains all kinds of records about the history of our province. These are held in central Cape Town.

To make the records of smaller places, like Moorreesburg, more accessible to people, copies of selected documents, photographs, maps, and oral history interviews from the Archives, about the town, are placed in a Travelling Archive in the local Museum and the Library for anyone to use.

This edition of the Travelling Archive is called *Moorreesburg se Trommel*.

WHO CAN USE IT?

Learners, teachers, museum educators, librarians and any community member can use the kit for their own research in the Library or Museum.

The Museum identified Grade 8 Geography learners, doing research for their project on settlement, and Grade 4 Social Science learners, learning about their local area, when we chose what to put in the kit so these learners will find it especially helpful.
