APPLICATION IN TERMS OF THE NATIONAL ENVIRONMENTAL MANAGEMENT ACT, 1998 (ACT 107 OF 1998) AND PART 2 OF CHAPTER 4 OF THE ENVIRONMENTAL IMPACT ASSESSMENT REGULATIONS, 2014 AS WELL AS THE APPLICATION FOR THE AMENDMENT OF THE ENVIRONMENTAL AUTHORISATION (ISSUED ON 24 NOVEMBER 2008, DEA&DP REF NO. EG12/2/1-AG3-5516) IN TERMS OF PART 2 OF CHAPTER 5 OF THE ENVIRONMENTAL IMPACT ASSESSMENT REGULATIONS, 2014: PROPOSED DEVELOPMENT OF A RESIDENTIAL ESTATE ON PORTION 53 OF THE FARM KRAAIBOSCH 195, GEORGE

- 1. With reference to the aforementioned applications, the Department hereby notifies you of its decision to-
 - (a) grant the amendment to the Environmental Authorisation (issued on 24 November 2008, DEA&DP REF NO. EG12/2/1-AG3-5516) by way of a replacing the exiting valid environmental authorisation. The application to amend the environmental authorisation under DEA&DP Ref. 16/3/3/5/D2/19/0003/23, refers;
 - (b) grant Environmental Authorisation in respect of the Preferred Alternative applied for, as described in the Integrated Final Basic Assessment Report ("FBAR") and Final Impact Report as applied for in application (DEA&DP Ref. 16/3/3/1/D2/19/0007/23); and
 - (c) issue a single environmental authorisation under DEA&DP Ref. 16/3/3/1/D2/19/0007/23, together with the reasons for the decision.

- 2. In terms of Regulation 4 of the Environmental Impact Assessment Regulations, 2014, you are instructed to ensure, within 14 days of the date of the Environmental Authorisation, that all registered interested and affected parties ("I&APs") are provided with access to and reasons for the decision, and that all registered I&APs are notified of their right to appeal.
- 3. Your attention is drawn to Chapter 2 of the Appeal Regulations, 2014, which prescribes the appeal procedure to be followed. This procedure is summarised in the attached Environmental Authorisation.
