APPLICATION FOR ENVIRONMENTAL AUTHORISATION AND THE ADOPTION OF A MAINTENANCE MANAGEMENT PLAN ("MMP") IN TERMS OF THE NATIONAL ENVIRONMENTAL MANAGEMENT ACT, 1998 (ACT 107 OF 1998) AND THE ENVIRONMENTAL IMPACT ASSESSMENT REGULATIONS, 2014, (AS AMENDED): REPAIR AND UPGRADE OF EXISTING DEGRADED STORMWATER INFRASTRUCTURE (CULVERTS AND A BRIDGE) AND THE CONSTRUCTION OF ADDITIONAL STRUCTURES AT KM 33.18, KM 36.22, KM 39.11, KM 39.47, KM 40.91 AND KM 42.99 ALONG MAIN ROAD 267 BETWEEN STANFORD AND RIVIERSONDEREND
