APPLICATION IN TERMS OF THE NATIONAL ENVIRONMENTAL MANAGEMENT ACT, 1998 (ACT NO. 107 OF 1998) ("NEMA") AND THE ENVIRONMENTAL IMPACT ASSESSMENT ("EIA") REGULATIONS, 2014: PROPOSED CLEARANCE OF INDIGENOUS VEGETATION TO ESTABLISH CULTIVATED LANDS ON ERVEN 2178 AND 2179, HOPEFIELD.
