With reference to your application for the abovementioned, find below the outcome with respect to this application.

**EXEMPTION NOTICE:**

**A. DECISION**

By virtue of the powers conferred on it by the NEMA and the NEMA EIA Regulations, 2014 (as amended) the competent authority herewith grants exemption to the applicant from a provision of the NEMA EIA Regulations, 2014 (as amended):

Exemption is **granted** from the following provision of the NEMA EIA Regulations, 2014 (as amended):

Regulation 12 (1): "A proponent or applicant must appoint an EAP at own cost to manage the application. Provided that an EAP need not be appointed for an application to amend an environmental authorisation where no environmental impact assessment or part thereof is required as part of such amendment application."

**B. REASONS FOR THE DECISION:**

1. The person to conduct the Environmental Impact Assessment Process is appropriately qualified and experienced.
2. The environment and the rights of interested and affected parties are not likely to be adversely affected by the decision to grant the exemption.
3. No objections were raised by interested and affected parties with respect to the exemption application.

### **C. APPEAL:**

Appeals must comply with the provisions contained in the National Appeal Regulations 2014.

1. An appellant (if the holder) must –

1.1. Submit an appeal in accordance with Regulation 4 to the Appeal Administrator and a copy of the appeal to any registered I&APs, any Organ of State with interest in the matter and the decision maker within 20 (twenty) calendar days from the date the holder was notified by the Competent Authority of this decision:

2. An appellant (if NOT the holder) must –

2.1. Submit an appeal in accordance with Regulation 4 to the Appeal Administrator, and a copy of the appeal to the holder, any registered I&AP, any Organ of State with interest in the matter and the decision maker within 20 (twenty) calendar days from the date the holder notified the registered I&APs of the this decision:

3. The holder (if not the appellant), the decision-maker, I&AP and Organ of State must submit their responding statements, if any, to the appeal authority and the appellant within 20 (twenty) calendar days from the date of receipt of the appeal submission.
