**RECTIFICATION OF ADMINISTRATIVE ERROR IN THE VARIATION OF THE WASTE MANAGEMENT PERMIT IN TERMS OF THE NATIONAL ENVIRONMENTAL MANAGEMENT: WASTE ACT, 2008 (ACT NO. 59 OF 2008) FOR THE OPERATION OF THE STEYNSKLOOF (RIVERSDALE) WASTE DISPOSAL FACILITY, PORTION OF THE REMAINDER OF ERF 2001, RIVERSDALE, HESSEQUA MUNICIPALITY**

1. Please refer to the Waste Management Variation Permit issued by this Department on 01 August 2018.
2. Regulation 27(4) of the National Environmental Management Act, 1998 (Act No. 107 of 1998) Environment Impact Assessment (EIA) Regulations, 2014: Government Notice No. R. 982 of 14 December 2014, specifies that an Environmental Authorisation, including a Waste Management Permit, may be amended by correcting a technical or editorial error that will not significantly affect the potential impacts to the environment or the health and wellbeing of interested and affected parties.
3. Furthermore, section 54(1)(d) of the NEM:WA, 2008 specifies that a Licensing Authority may vary a waste management permit to make a non-substantive variation.
4. With reference to the above, this Department acknowledges the administrative error as reflected reflected in the following:
